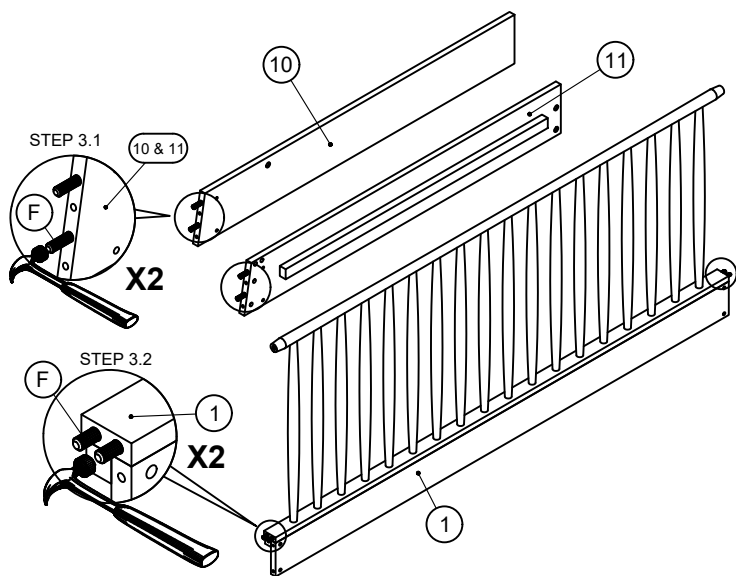
- 1** used plastic hammer insert all (3) and (4) into (1) and use (N) to tighten in (3)



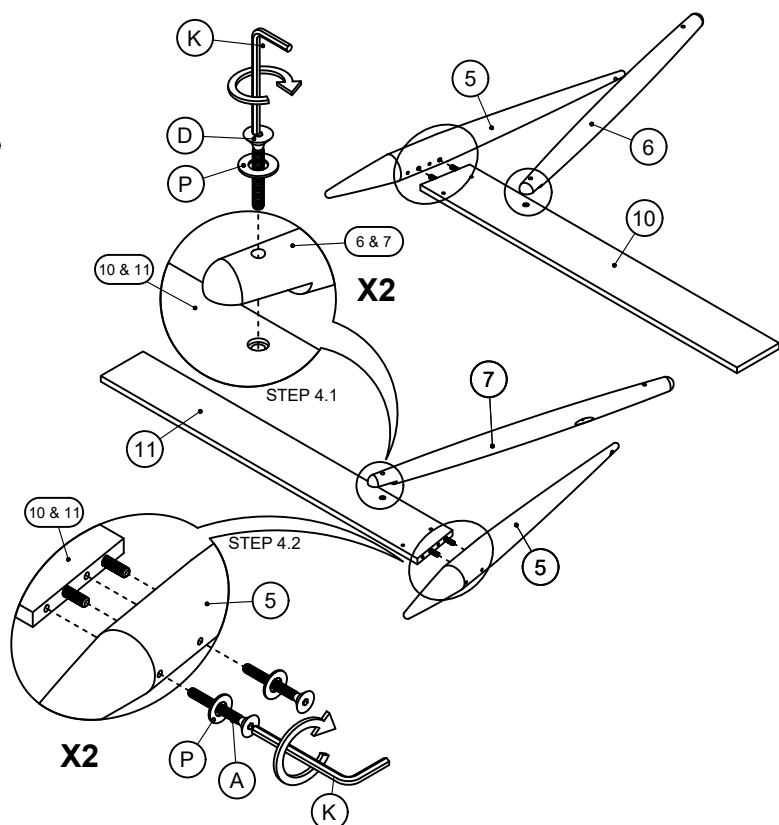
- 2** used plastic hammer insert 2 into (3) and (4) and use (N) to tighten in (3)



- 3** knock the Item(F) wood dowel into the (10)&(11)&(1) hole.



- 4** Insert (P) on (D) tighten them with (K) and Insert (P) on (A) tighten them with K in the relative positions according to the figure.



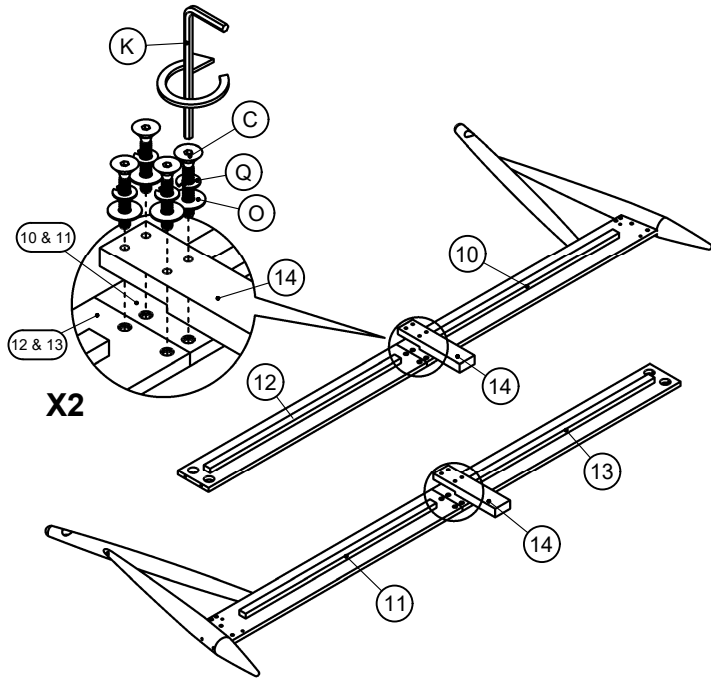
### Cleaning & Care

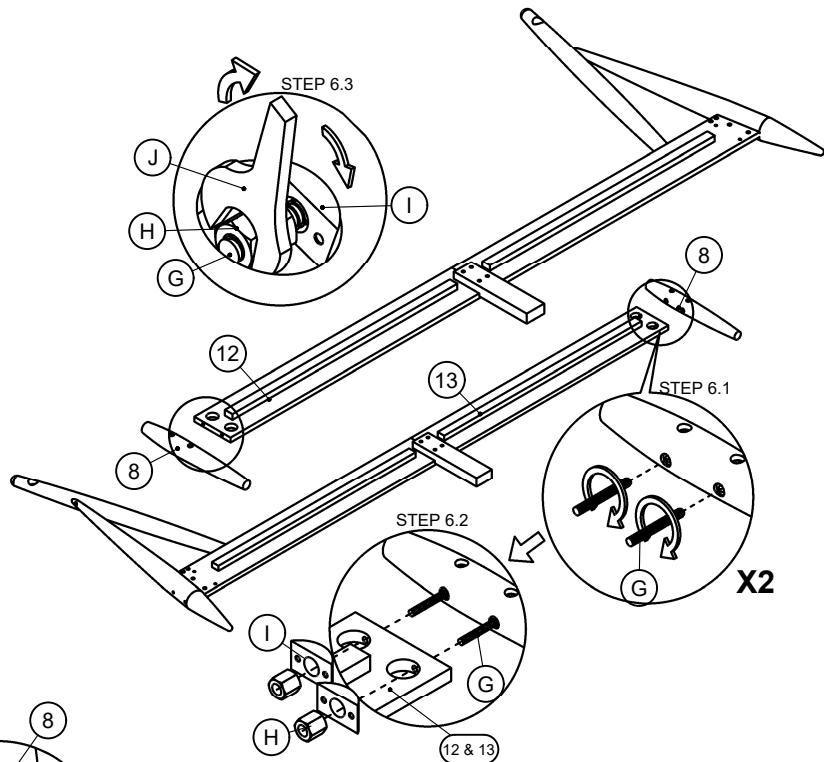

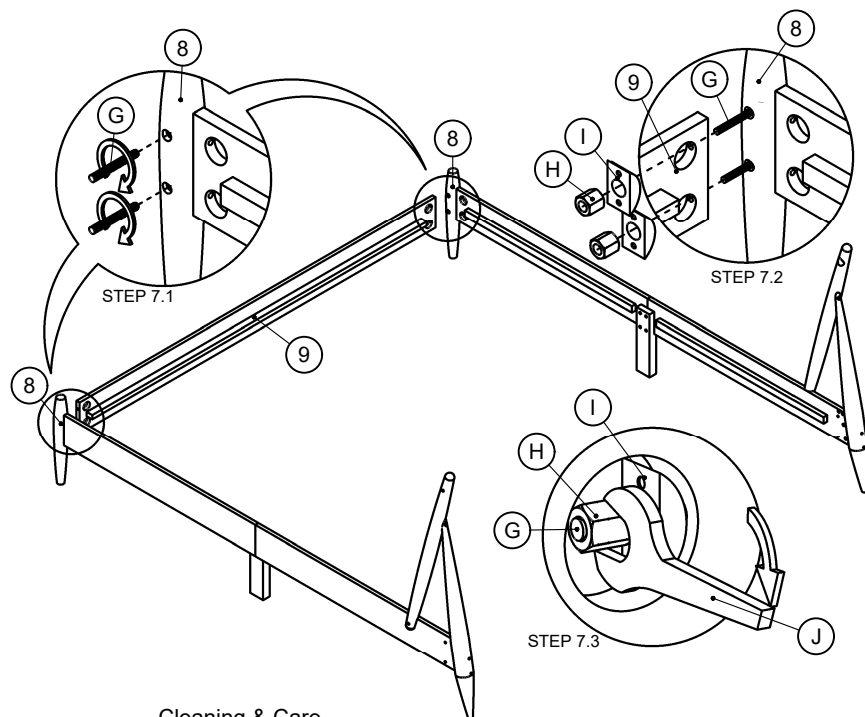
- 5** Insert (Q) AND (O) on (C) then tighten them with (K) the relative positions according to the figure.



- 6** Insert (G) into (8) then insert (12) and (13) respectively into (G) that has just been connected to (8), then tighten (J) to (H) & (I)



- 7** Insert (G) into (8) then insert (9) into (G) that has just been connected to (8), then tighten (J) to (H) & (I)



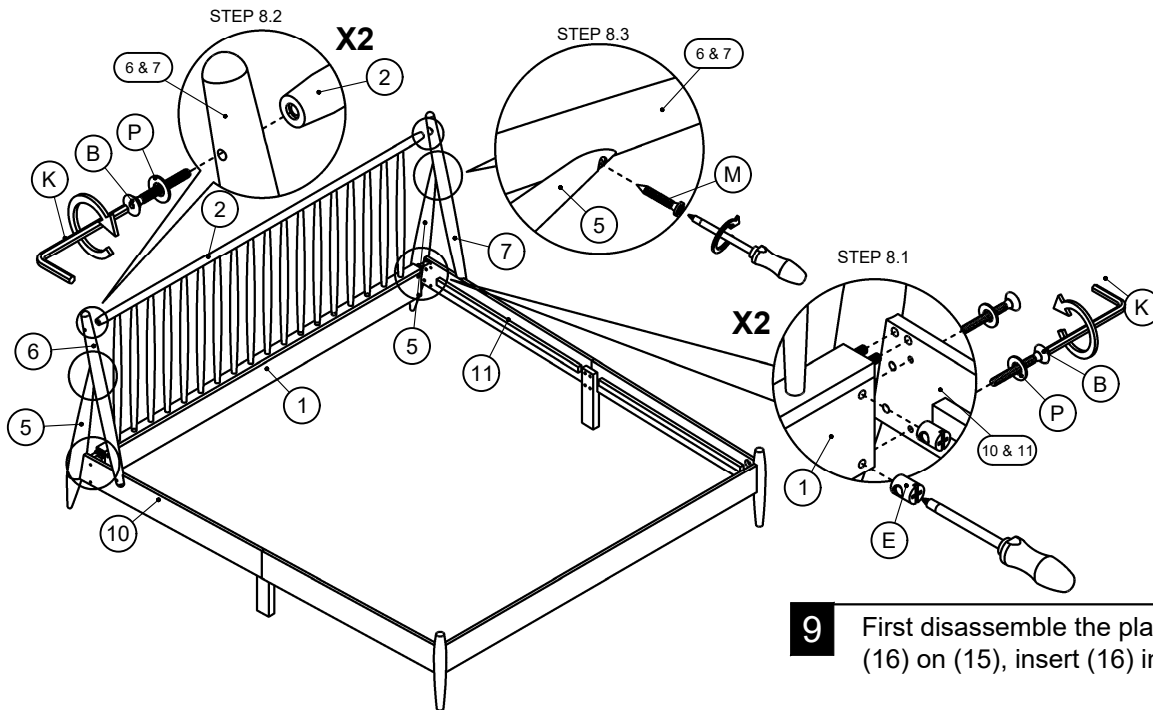
### Cleaning & Care

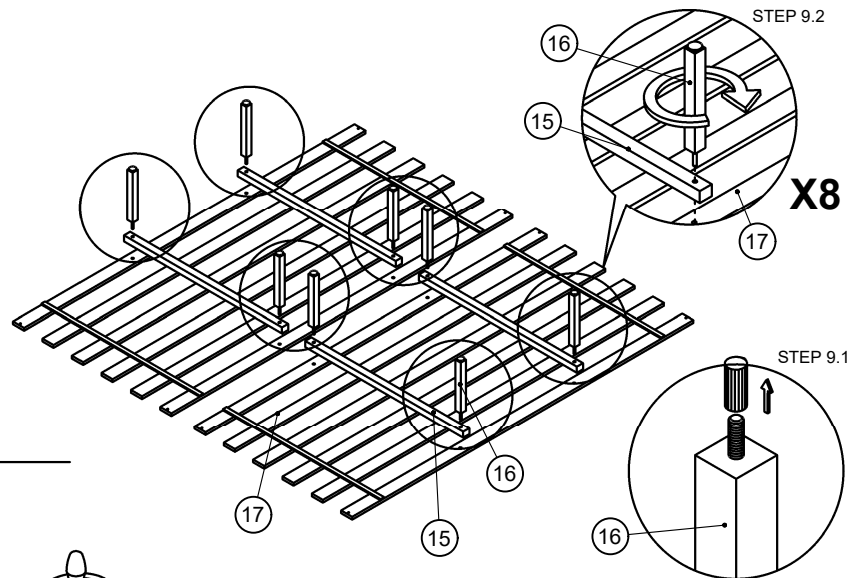

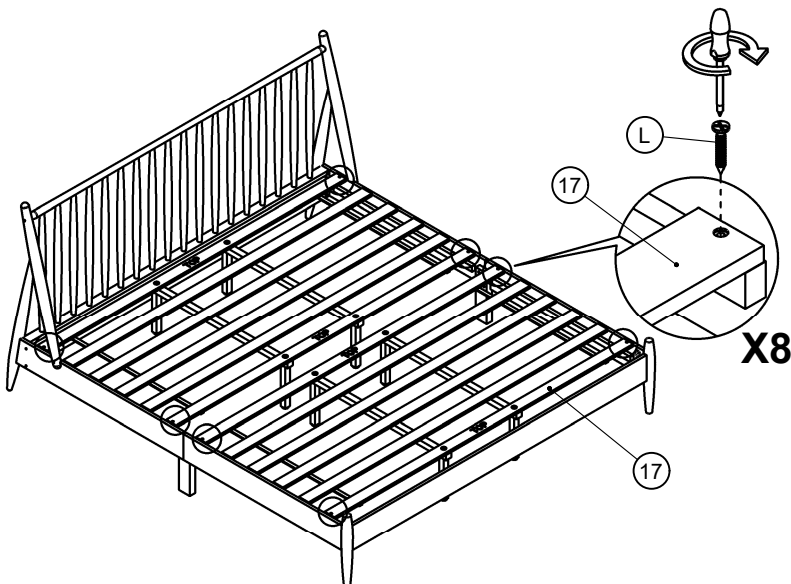
- 8** Insert (E) to (1) then insert (P) to (B) Then use (K) to tighten them relative positions according to the figure. used (M) tighten into (5)



- 9** First disassemble the plastic on the hanger bolt, then install (16) on (15), insert (16) into (15) and (17) and tighten



- 10** Turn (L) into the screw (17) using the Screwdriver then (Fully tighten all of screw and JCBC!!)
